## BIOGRAPHY:

JARED GRABB is the working man's singer/songwriter. He has been recording and touring for the last decade, performing both solo and with the bands: SCOUTS HONOR (No Idea Records/Thinker Thought Records), THE FORECAST (Eyeball Records/Victory Records/Thinker Thought Records), and CHERRY LANE (Thinker Thought Records). During this time he has recorded over 100 songs and played over 1000 shows (183 solo) across the United States, Germany, and Switzerland. All of this while running his own independent record label, Thinker Thought Records.

*WHERE DO YOU HIDE YOUR LOVE SONGS?* departs from the abrasive tendencies of Mr. Grabb's previous work with SCOUTS HONOR and falls in snugly with SCOUTS HONOR's few quieter, more melodic and, some might say, "folk" or "country" moments. Influence from the likes of Woody Guthrie, Johnny Cash, and Son House is plain to see. But, *WHERE DO YOU HIDE YOUR LOVE SONGS?* goes further to incorporate modern pop elements similar to Death Cab For Cutie, Feist, Wilco, or Gaslight Anthem. These songs will get you humming and toe tapping in the short term, while retaining the lyrical depth to find their long term home in your personal collection of precious audio gems.
